A guide for school leaders

1. Access the website at <http://twitter.com/signup>
2. Enter your sign-up details:

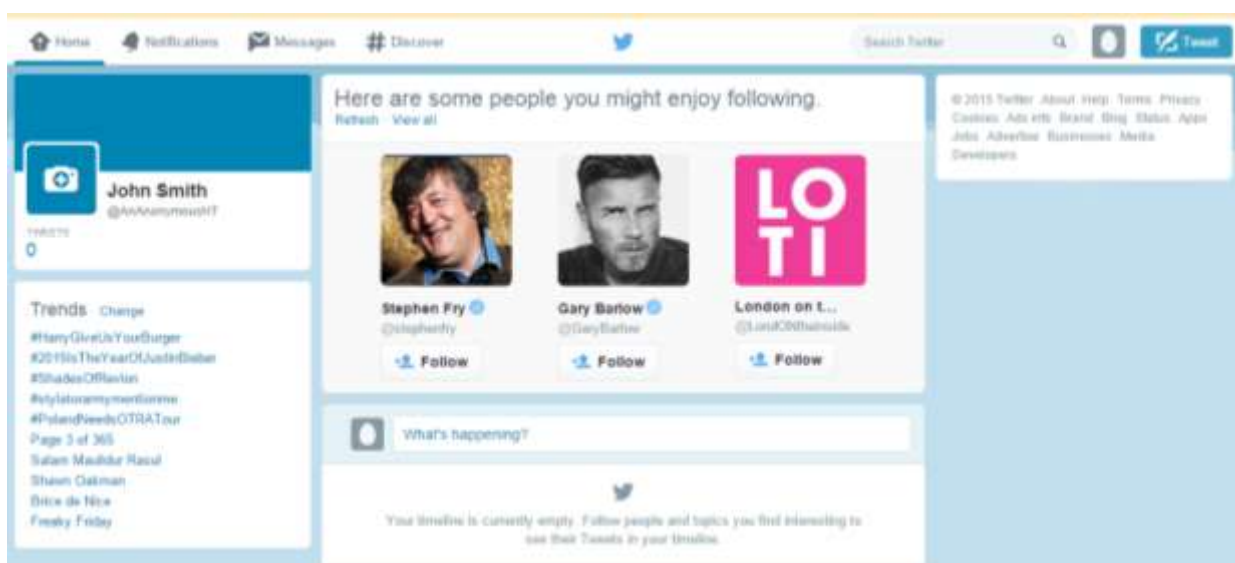
